

Ed.volve Privacy Policy & Student Data Privacy Notice

EVOLV.ED SERVICES LLC, doing business as Ed.volve, (hereinafter “Ed.volve,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) is committed to protecting the privacy and security of student data and other personal information collected in connection with the delivery of its educational services.

This document represents a consolidated view of Ed.volve’s privacy-related materials and describes how personal and student data is collected, used, protected, shared, retained, and managed when Ed.volve provides educational services.

This policy is intended to align with applicable privacy and data protection laws, including but not limited to:

- New York State Education Law §2-d
- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
- Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)
- Other applicable federal and state privacy laws

1. Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to:

- Students
- Parents and legal guardians
- Educators and administrators
- School districts and educational institutions
- Authorized users and partners accessing Ed.volve services

It covers Ed.volve’s educational content, digital instructional materials, and related services delivered through its platform.

2. Educational Platform & Data Roles

Ed.volve delivers educational content and services through the **MagicBox** platform.

For purposes of student data protection:

- Educational institutions retain ownership and control of student data
- Ed.volve acts as a service provider delivering educational services
- MagicBox acts as a data processor, hosting and processing data on Ed.volve's behalf

Ed.volve processes student data only as necessary to provide educational services, consistent with principles of purpose limitation and data minimization, and as directed by the applicable educational institution.

3. Information Collected

Ed.volve collects and processes only the minimum student data necessary to support and deliver contracted educational services, as directed by the applicable educational institution.

Student Data

May include:

- First and last name
- School-issued email address or username
- School or district affiliation
- Educational performance or completion data

Educator and Administrator Data

May include:

- Name
- Professional email address
- School or district affiliation
- Account access credentials

Technical and Usage Data

May include:

- Device and browser information
- System log and access data used for security, functionality, and troubleshooting

Ed.volve does not collect biometric data.

4. Purpose of Data Use

Student and user data is used solely to:

- Deliver educational content and instructional materials
- Support teaching and learning activities
- Maintain platform functionality, reliability, and security

Student data is not used for advertising, marketing, or non-educational commercial purposes.

5. Ownership and Control of Student Data

All student data remains the property of, and under the control of, the applicable school district, school, or educational institution.

Ed.volve does not claim ownership of student data and processes such data only as required to provide educational services.

6. Data Protection & Security Safeguards

Ed.volve maintains reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect student data, including:

- Access controls and authentication mechanisms
- Secure hosting environments
- Encryption of data in transit
- Contractual data protection obligations for service providers

Security practices are designed to align with applicable laws and industry standards.

7. Data Sharing

Ed.volve does not sell or rent student data.

Student data may be shared only when necessary to:

- Provide educational services
- Comply with legal obligations
- Work with authorized service providers or sub processors under applicable data protection agreements

All data sharing is subject to applicable privacy and data protection requirements.

8. Data Retention & Deletion

Student data is retained only for the duration necessary to fulfill educational, contractual, and legal obligations.

Upon termination of services or upon request by the educational institution, student data is securely deleted or returned in accordance with applicable agreements and laws.

9. Data Breach Notification

In the event of a data breach involving student data, Ed.volve will notify the affected educational institution without unreasonable delay and provide information known at the time, in accordance with applicable law.

10. Parents' Bill of Rights for Data Privacy

Parents and legal guardians have the right to:

- Know how student data is collected and used
- Assurance that student data is not sold or used for marketing purposes
- Request access to or correction of student data through the school or district
- Understand how student data is protected and retained

Requests related to student education records should be directed to the student's school or district, which maintains control over those records.

11. External Links & Third-party Integrations

Ed.volve content may include links to or integrations with third-party platforms, resources, or applications—including AI-driven or enabled services. When users navigate to, access or interact with third-party services, these external services are governed by their own privacy policies and this Privacy Policy no longer applies.

12. Policy Updates

Ed.volve may update this Privacy Policy as required by changes in law or operational practices. Updates will take effect upon publication, and material changes may be communicated to contracted educational institutions.
